### NOTICE

The USBC is liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in this tournament through delay, unexpected, yet necessary schedule changes or premature termination of this tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of causes relating to or resulting there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of USBC.

**USBC JUNIOR GOLD EVENT**  
**TOURNAMENT DATES: APRIL 25, 26, May 2, 3, 2009**  
**ARIZONA STATE USBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. **Tournament open to** all boys and girls in good standing who have a 2008-2009 USBC Youth Division Membership and who are members of the Arizona USBC.
2. **Tournament divisions** will be according to averages and will be handicapped.
3. Entrants may enter each event **only once** and bowl three (3) games in each event. Entrants into team event may not move to another team if team has legal lineup.
4. Entrants **must enter singles and doubles to bowl either**. The doubles event will be bowled first. Teams (4 player) and doubles may be mixed, all boys or all girls.
5. **Averages for entrants will be as follows:** (1) Highest verified league average as of February 1, 2009, based on a minimum of fifteen (15) games; (2) 2008 verified fifteen (15) games or more summer league average. Any entrant not having any of the above will use their highest verified league average of 15 games or more as of April 25, 2009. Entrants not having a verified league average prior to their first event will bowl scratch.
6. **An alphabetical average report from each center**, listing all bowlers, first and last names, total pins, number of games and average as of February 1, 2009 is required to be sent to the Leon Allen, Tournament Director's Office, 911 N. Walnut, Casa Grande, AZ 85222. Verify that your center has sent in the required report.
7. **Handicap** will be based on ninety (90%) percent of the difference between the entrants average and 220 for Singles and All Events; 440 for Doubles; 880 for Team.
8. **Substitutes** will be allowed in the same line-up position. Substitutes will report at least one (1) hour prior to scheduled time to bowl, with properly filled out substitute form to include bowler's name, age, average and certification number and association name and number. Once a substitution is completed in any event, the original entrant may not bowl in that spot at that time. **Substitutes are not eligible for all events unless** they bowled in all three (3) events for the same original entrant and the optional all events fee was paid. Each area is responsible for obtaining their substitutes.
9. **Entries will be scheduled on a first received, first serve basis**. Those within a seventy five (75) mile radius of the tournament site may be scheduled for two (2) weekends.
10. **Check in, for all events, may be done on an individual basis**. Check in time is one half (1/2) hour prior to squad time. **Certification cards are required at check in**. Anyone not checked in ten (10) minutes prior to squad time, may be replaced, if replacement available. **If a team is short one pre-paid bowler, an absentee score of ten pins under the average of the absent bowler, plus his/her handicap may be used** (one absentee score per team, USBC Rule 322b). After checking in, Bowler must remain in Bowling Center.
11. **Tardy bowlers**, who have not been replaced, will begin play for score beginning with the frame being bowled. Frames missed will be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
12. **Awards and Scholarships:** **Awards** will be given in each handicap division, Team, Doubles and Singles. Additional places will be presented awards if entries warrant. Singles will be divided into Boy and Girl divisions. **Scholarships for Handicap Scores ONLY** will be given to the **First Place Team, Doubles, Singles in each division**. **OPTIONAL ALL EVENTS Scholarships: To be eligible for an All Events Scholarship Award, entrant must have paid the Optional Scholarship All Events Fee.** Awards & Scholarship fees returned 100 %. Scholarships to be administered by the USBC Smart Program. Account #8583. (Additional scholarships if entries warrant).
13. **Junior Gold Event** is an optional event for Jr Gold Members ONLY with a \$30.00 entry fee payable at the tournament site of the entrant's first event. Criteria to become a Gold Member: (1) Entrant must have a minimum average of 165 for girls and 175 for boys; (2) Purchase a new Gold Membership card at tournament site for \$30.00 fee. Entrants in the Gold Event must bowl all three events. All nine games will be used to determine the Gold Event winners. Qualifying is based on scratch scores. ONE out of five will receive entry into the Junior Gold National Tournament to be held July 2009.
14. **Appeals and protests** must be confirmed in writing to AZ STATE USBC YOUTH no later than seventy two (72) hours after such action or the decision of the Tournament Director will stand.
15. **Dress Code: Appropriate dress will be worn, neat, clean and proper fitting. NON-TATTERED BLOUSES/SHIRTS MUST HAVE SLEEVES AND BE HIP LENGTH IF NOT TUCKED IN. ANKLE LENGTH PANTS/JEANS ONLY.** No caps/hats. Clothing that advertises alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products or depicts foul language or gestures will not be permitted. No undergarment can be exposed.
16. **General:** Entrants will not be permitted to smoke, chew tobacco or consume alcoholic beverages while participating in this tournament. Food and drink must be kept on the back counter or table area. Entrants taking food into the bowling/settee area are subject to disqualification..
17. **The AZ STATE USBC shall not be responsible** for accidents that occur while traveling to or from the tournament site or during the tournament.
